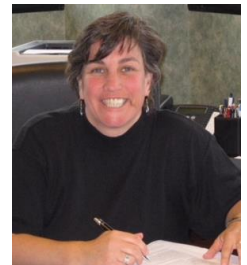
### David Covington, LPC, MBA

### Training: Crisis Response Planning (5 CEUs) (Separate Track)

- This full-day workshop is designed to enhance professionals’ knowledge about crisis response planning for managing acute suicide risk, and to increase their ability to confidently and competently administer this intervention with at-risk individuals. The first half of the workshop provides didactic knowledge about suicide, the development of the crisis response plan intervention, and its empirical support, all of which are designed to increase clinician knowledge. The workshop also includes clinical demonstrations by the instructor and skills practice by attendees, which are designed for clinicians to acquire skill competency.
